The LPN to ADN Bridge has a limited capacity. Once it fills to capacity, students will be offered a place on a waiting list based on their eligibility date. Once all items on page 1 have been completed, you will be able to accept your position on the waitlist. Wait times change often due to fluctuations in student interest. FAQs

Q. How long is the waitlist?

A. Wait times vary due to fluctuations in student interest. You will accept your position on the waitlist when ALL admissions items are complete. Wait times can be greater than 6 months.

Q. What if I have transfer credits?

A. A transfer review is automatically completed AFTER you have applied AND submitted your official transcripts. If you had fewer than 60 college credits at a C or higher, you must also send your high school transcripts. It can take up to 2 weeks for transfer credits to be processed. If you have completed Nursing CORE courses at another college, you must be in good standing and core courses are reviewed for approval by the health division. Visit go.nwtc.edu/good-standing to complete the letter of good standing.

Q. What is the schedule like?

A. The LPN to ADN Bridge program is available part-time only. Due to variations in clinical availability and days/times, we are unable to provide exact days and times until closer to the start of clinicals. You can expect to be on campus up to 2 days/nights per week.
