Nurses Training Program Scholarships Brown-Kewaunee County Voiture #774 | Deadline: May 20, 2025

The Forty & Eight is an independent honor organization of US veterans originally formed as an arm of the American Legion. Membership is by invitation of honorably discharged veterans and honorably serving members of the US Armed Forces. The boxcar of the French Railways, so familiar to American ground troops during WWI, was chosen as the symbolic heart of the organization. The French/Railroad theme is prominent throughout the organization. Members were called Voyageurs Militaire (military travelers). The "40/8" (40 men and 8 horses) cargo capacity sign emblazoned on each French boxcar that had carried American doughboys to the front lines and the "French horizon blue" color became the symbols of the society. In 1955, the Voiture Nationale recognized the growing shortage of nurses in this country and formally established the Nurses Training Program. Since then, the program has helped more than 52,000 nurses obtain their degrees by contributing in excess of \$32 million in scholarships. The Brown-Kewaunee County Voiture #774 continues this tradition by offering scholarships to nursing students in the Green Bay area to help them reach their goals of becoming registered nurses.
